

MOVIE REVIEW: Grindhouse: Death Proof (2007)

If you don't like this sort of movie, this film will give you more reasons to not like this sort of movie. *Death Proof* features some seriously tough chicks. No, do not even think about taking any of these girls home to meet your mother. Kurt Russell is superb in his role. This movie is one of the best in it's genre.
