

# **One Year Bible Challenge:** To read the entire Bible in one year, beginning on January 1, 2011.

This is your invitation to join the One Year Bible Challenge.

**What:** Read the Whole Bible in one year

**When:** January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011

**Where:** Anywhere (see information below about study groups)

**How:** Using the One Year Bible

## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

**Q.** How often do I need to read the Bible?

**A.** Every day, for one year.

**Q.** How long will it take me to read, each day?

**A.** Probably between 10 to 20 minutes per day, depending on how fast you read.

**Q.** What study groups are organized?

**A.** So far...

1. **The Saturday morning Men's Breakfast**--7:30 am every Saturday morning at a restaurant in Davie. Tom Truex is leading this group. You can contact him at 954-792-6800, or via the web site, [www.ReadTheWholeBible.COM](http://www.ReadTheWholeBible.COM).
2. **The Family Bible Study** meets in Davie, every other Saturday evening. Individuals, couples, and families with children are welcome. This group is being lead by Doug Notman. His phone number is 954-473-9899

**Q.** I don't have time to read the Bible. I don't see how it is possible to commit to reading the whole Bible in a year.

**A.** This might not be the right year for you to read the whole Bible. But before you decide, I suggest you determine how much time you *waste*, every day? For many people (including me) it is a LOT of time! Can you plan your day more efficiently to free up 10 to 20 minutes of this activity/inactivity every day?

**Q.** I don't know too much about the Bible. Will this project be too advanced for me?

**A.** No. The version of the Bible which we will be using is the NIV, which reads very easily—in common, simple language for modern readers. No prior Bible knowledge is required.

**Q.** I'm NOT A CHRISTIAN/BELIEVER. May I still attend the study group(s)?

**A.** Yes. The study groups are not debate sessions, nor a defense of Christianity. If you have an open mind and want to learn, please join us. You choose whether or not to believe. We typically have a time of Christian prayer and worship during each meeting.

**Q.** What's the cost?

**A.** Nothing (hopefully). We are trying to provide all Bibles at no cost to participants. If you are financially able to help defray the cost of Bibles for others, your assistance will be appreciated, but not required.

**Q.** Why join a study group?

**A.** It's not required. We want to encourage one another in our Bible reading. The study groups will discuss some of the stories and broad themes of the Bible. One year is too short for an in depth study of the entire Bible.

**Q.** What additional study group(s) are needed, and how do I form one?

**A.** We do not have a women's group yet, although we have heard some interest. You may want to organize a group at your church, school or work. If you contact us, we would like to support and publicize your group.

**Q.** Which study group should I attend?

**A.** You can attend either or both. There is so much potential material each week, so I anticipate very little overlap.

**Q.** Will daily Bible reading dramatically change my life?

**A.** Yes

**Q.** Were all of these questions really frequently asked?

**A.** No.
