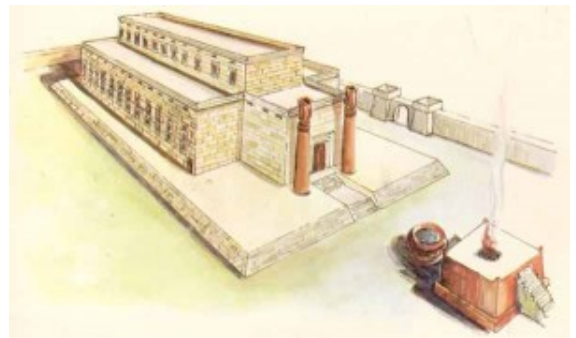


Week 29, One Year Bible Challenge: "All are Sinners"
